I have to be honest about needing help, accepting that I am a compulsive eater, that I do not have the answers, and so much more. I have to be honest about needing God at this moment, and this one, and this one, and feeling myself relax as I type these words so that God can enter my heart and make me feel whole. Recovery is not in the food. Food is a solution, but it's not the solution I am looking for! It will take me down a certain path that I know well. I choose the other path today, the path of freedom from food, the path where food takes its proper place on the side of the road. My goal is to reach perfect union with God, and nothing can get in the way of that.
