
KNOWING MY STORY AND BEING ABLE TO TELL IT TO SOMEONE IS THE BEGINNING OF RECOVERY.

When I started working the OA program I thought it was selfish, but I did it anyway because I was desperate to find a cure for my compulsive overeating. When I let go of doing things for others because they wanted me to, and doing things for myself because it was the right thing to do, leading me to health, I started to release resentments and think of service in a totally different way. I saw that my motives were the key to performing service. I began to read my feelings when asked or told to do something, I began to say "no." Over time, I realized that for me service to God, through esteem-able acts toward myself, is the rent I pay for being. This way, I don't have any spare time. Service is not what I thought growing up. It is my response to God's grace and mercy.

Renewal was something I was looking for in each diet or weight loss attempt. I wanted to be renewed but into something different. I wanted to be remade, from the beginning, as a different person. I didn't understand the concept of renewal until I had been in this program a very long time. It was only when I began to see each day as a new beginning that I began to understand that I could renew myself in recovery rather than in disease but that I had to do it every day and, specifically, every morning before the day got away from me. A day is like the waves on the ocean. It is too easy to get caught in the current and drift out to sea. I must pay attention to each wave, anticipate it, and either go under it, or go with it toward the shore. God is in this moment of choice and renewal.
