Seeking God's Will

My prayer to my Higher Power lately has been "show me". Show me what I need to do to take care of myself. Show me what I need to do as I approach another one of those crossroads in life. I ask to know God's will and be graced with the power to carry it out. I pray that my will aligns with my Higher Power's. When I let go and let God, I am much more serene, and staying abstinent is not a struggle.

So what is my will and what is God's will? I still get confused occasionally. During my quiet time, I have been focusing on a passage in our "Twelve and Twelve", where it suggests in Step Eleven, p. 97, that I ask God to increase the desire for something if it is God's will and decrease it if it is not. In the past my prayers were lists of what I wanted. It never entered my consciousness that certain desires were not good for me.

I have also been meditating on a passage from p. 560 of AA's "Big Book". It states that we are taught to differentiate between our wants (which are never satistifed) and our needs (which are always provided for). My disease is one of "not enough". Before program, nothing was ever enough. I was always waiting for something to materialize that would make me happy. Today I am grateful that on most days I have a sense of spiritual abundance and I feel good in my own skin. I am confident that God will fulfill my needs.

There are days when I have the "I wants" and I take it to prayer and meditation. The God of my understanding does not say no. The answer is yes if my will conforms with my Higher Power's will. Sometimes I see what I think are obstacles. What I realize later is that the obstacles were really my HP saying "not yet" because my timing was off. Other times I want something that never happens. God later makes it clear to me that, despite my flurry of activity because of self will run riot, what I wanted was not in my best interest. God puts something else there for me instead and says, "Child, I've got something better." Coming to believe that my Higher Power loves me unconditionally has changed my life.
