REMINDERS FROM THE BIG BOOK

CARRY THIS MESSAGE

The 12th step asks us to carry **this** message to Compulsive Overeaters. What message is that? The message in the *Big Book*.

We are told on page xvii, line 30, that during the time before the *Big Book* was written, people in A.A. were in a "flying-blind period". If we choose to try to live an abstinent life on the basis of what we hear rather than on the basis of what the *Big Book* offers, are we not "flying blind"?

CHANGE

On page 12, lines 27-28, Bill W. says may the "scales of pride and prejudice {fall} from my eyes" so that "a new world {might come} into view".

Dr. W.D. Silkworth said in "The Doctor's Opinion", "I earnestly advise every alcoholic (compulsive overeater) to read this book through, and though perhaps he came to scoff, he may remain to pray". (p. xxx, lines 5-7)

REMAIN TO PRAY

Thus, in order to gain a new experience from reading the *Big Book*, I invite you to pray the following prayer: "God, I know the danger of flying blind. I know that words repeated orally can sometimes be misconstrued. Give me, therefore, an open mind that the words of our *Big Book* might be impressed anew upon my mind, my heart, and my soul more clearly. Let me enjoy a new and greater experience than any I have yet received. Let my reading take me to a higher level of spiritual maturity, and then inspire me to go forward and share more clearly the message of this program."

AN INVITATION

I invite you, therefore, to read the *Big Book* and – to use a line from the book itself – to "look at it from an entirely different angle". (p. 66, lines 25-26)
